# CALL FOR ART

*Create some artwork to help CCF celebrate its 60th Anniversary*

*In celebration of CCF's founding in 1960, an art exhibit at the Gleason Public Library was planned for 2020 and then for 2021. Due to limitations on public gatherings caused by the pandemic, the exhibition has been rescheduled for fall 2022.*

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The Carlisle Conservation Foundation is celebrating its 60+ years of work protecting open space in Carlisle with an exhibition of artworks inspired by Carlisle's Preserved Open Spaces. This Call for Art is open to Carlisle residents of all ages and to everyone who loves Carlisle's Open Spaces.

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**1.** Artwork should be inspired by any of the CCF-owned properties and CCF-held Conservation Restrictions. Lists of properties and their locations are on the next 2 pages of this document. A map of the town showing the location of each property can be downloaded from our website: [carlisleconservationfoundation.org](http://carlisleconservationfoundation.org)

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**2.** The exhibition will take place between October and December 2022. Artists may be inspired by the splendors of the seasonal displays of Carlisle's natural environment: Winter, Spring, Summer, and/or Fall.

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**3.** Artists may work in any media including photography, drawings and paintings, fabric and fiber, in both two and three dimensions (3D artwork must fit in the library's display cases). Artwork must be appropriate for display at the Gleason Public Library. The library's "Art at the Gleason" guidelines are available from the [library website](#).

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**4.** Artists are encouraged to reach out to CCF with regard to the property or properties they may want to represent. All questions should be directed to [info1@ccf-web.org](mailto:info1@ccf-web.org).

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**5.** Once you have completed your artwork(s), please send a photo of the work, dimensions, whether any work will be offered for sale, and indicate which property has inspired you. We will get back to you at the appropriate time with information about delivery of the artwork and to get all necessary details for the library curators to prepare identifying labels. We look forward to seeing your creations.

### \*NOTE:

**CR #57** is the Town-owned Benfield Conservation Land, behind Benfield Farms, with a trail to a Viewing Platform overlooking the Spencer Brook. There are parking spaces reserved for trail access behind Benfield Farms.

**CR #68** is the Woodward Conservation Land off Maple Street near Bedford Road. The land is currently leased to a local farmer for grazing animals. There is no public parking and currently no public access.

**Except for CR #s 57 and 68, owned by the Town, all CRs held by CCF are on land that is privately owned. There is no public access to privately owned property.**

Artworks may be inspired by some of these private properties, such as the following:

**CRs #12,14,18** - Wetlands field visible to the NE from the corner of Westford and Curve Streets, also accessible via the public Hanover Hill Trail, with a dedicated parking spot near the Hanover Hill cul de sac

**CR #38** - Farm field w/grazing cattle, visible from the pathway along Bedford Rd. from Town Center towards Kimballs

**CRs #43, 63** - Former Valentine Farm fields visible to the SW and NW from the corner of West and Acton Streets

**CR #49** - Clark Farm, with its iconic barn and silo visible from Concord Street, currently home to the Clark Farm CSA

**CR #67** - Sorli Farm south field, visible from Westford Street west of Curve Street
